Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.		
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: • Social Security Number • Account transactions and balances • Assets and investment experience • Credit information and income		
How?	All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. Who is providing this notice?	Citizens Financial Group, Inc. and its family of companies.
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What we do

How does Citizens protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that are designed to comply with applicable law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. For more information on the safety of your information, visit Citizens’ Security .
How does Citizens collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you • Open an account or perform transactions • Pay your bills or apply for a loan • Enter into an investment advisory contract • Use your credit card or debit card • Seek advice about your investments We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can’t I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only • Sharing for affiliates’ everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness • Affiliates from using your information to market to you • Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See “Other important information” below for more on your rights under state law.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account, I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • Our affiliates include those companies referenced below under the heading “Companies to which this notice applies.”
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • We do not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies and financial product or service companies.

Other important information

Vermont Residents: We will not disclose information about your creditworthiness to our affiliates other than as permitted by Vermont law, unless you authorize us to make those disclosures. California Residents: Under California law, we will not share information we collect about you outside of Citizens Financial Group and its family of companies unless permitted by California law. We will limit our sharing among our family of companies to the extent required by California law.
